

East Midlands Clinical Senate Leadership Fellow (medical and non-medical)

This is a unique opportunity for you to apply for the position of Clinical Fellow within the East Midlands Clinical Senate

'Supporting the development of clinical leaders within the East Midlands'

What is the role and function of the Clinical Senate? Clinical Senates are a source of independent, strategic advice and guidance to commissioners, integrated care systems, and other stakeholders, to assist them to make the best decisions about healthcare for the populations they represent.

Am I eligible to apply? You can apply for the position of Clinical Fellow if you are a healthcare professional in any multi-disciplinary role (higher specialist trainees or above/band 6 and above) and are currently working within the East Midlands.

What is the time commitment and will I be remunerated? The time commitment is four sessions per month (equivalent to two days per month) and payment will be based on this programmed activity. The Fellowship is for 12 months from April 2020 with a view to extend for a further 12 months. We are looking to appoint six fellows, one of which will have a digital focus.

What are the responsibilities of a Clinical Fellow? As a Clinical Fellow you will support the Clinical Senate Chair, Vice Chair and the Head of Clinical Senate with clinical review panels. Other specific responsibilities will include:


- Taking a joint lead on specific areas of work to be agreed
- Supporting the Clinical Senate's work programmes
- Writing and presenting reports as required
- Conducting literature searches and reviews
- Attending meetings with senior people within the East Midlands

Why should I apply? This is a unique opportunity to receive mentorship and support from senior staff and external colleagues and to be closely involved with the healthcare leadership agenda.
